• **Priority Date Policy Change – Effective March 27, 2023:** This is a reminder that beginning on Monday, March 27, 2023, the VCF will begin implementing the policy change announced at the January 25, 2023, law firm meeting related to the order in which claims are assigned for review. The VCF will no longer prioritize claims for review based solely on the claim submit date. Instead, we will prioritize claims that are ready for review based on whether they are "in good order."

For detailed information about this policy change, please reference the <u>notes and slides</u> from the January 2023 law firm meeting, specifically the "Policy Change" section.

This policy change only impacts claims that are submitted without the minimally required documents and information needed for the VCF to complete review of the claim. You do not need to worry about the impact of this policy if you ensure all claims you submit have the required documents and certified condition at the time the claim is submitted.

Thank you for assisting the VCF in the effort to focus our attention on those claims that are ready for review. Please direct all questions to our law firm liaisons.
