

VCF Program Statistics

Eligibility Statistics

The VCF has made substantial progress in determining whether claimants have met the statutory requirements to be found eligible for compensation for the Fund. The VCF has issued decisions in over 80% of the eligibility claims that are ready for decision¹. However, of the 13,863 Eligibility Forms that have been submitted, more than half (7,161) cannot be decided at this time because they either (i) do not contain a signed authorization giving the VCF legal authority to process the claim or (ii) are missing other information needed to establish eligibility. In these cases, the VCF will notify either the claimant or the claimant's attorney about the missing documentation and provide direction to appropriate resources. 
Of the 6,702 claims that contain signed authorizations and for which the claimant has a certified eligible condition, the VCF has issued decisions on 5,603 (84%). The remaining 16% (1,099) are currently under review to confirm that the other statutory requirements (such as presence at the WTC, debris removal route, or other 9/11 crash site) have been met.

¹ A claimant starts the VCF claim process by filing an Eligibility Form. However, the VCF cannot take action on the claim until the following requirements are met: (1) Properly signed authorizations are submitted to allow the VCF to obtain and review information specific to the claim; (2) The claimant has at least one certified eligible condition verified by the WTC Health Program either through direct treatment by the WTC Health Program or by providing required information from a treating physician outside of the WTC Health Program (or the claimant has a traumatic injury or an injury that was recognized as eligible in VCF1).





Compensation Statistics

Once a claimant is deemed eligible, the VCF begins review of the claimant's Compensation Form to determine how much compensation the claimant is entitled to receive from the Fund. So far, the VCF has received Compensation Forms for only about one third (37%) of the claims that have been found eligible. As with the Eligibility Form, the VCF is not able to take action on a claimant's Compensation Form without a signed authorization. Of the Compensation Forms that have been submitted, only 1,220 (60%) have the signature documents required to begin review. The remaining claims cannot be reviewed at this time either because they are missing the required signed authorization or because the VCF has already determined that the claim lacks sufficient documents needed to support the claimed loss. The VCF will notify either the claimant or the claimant's attorney about the missing documentation and provide direction to appropriate resources. Among claims with signed authorizations, the VCF has issued decisions on 502 claims (41%). The remaining 718 are under review to determine whether they have sufficient documentation to calculate compensation. Once the VCF has obtained the necessary documentation – including documentation




regarding the claimant's work capacity, compensation history, and relevant pensions and other benefits – the VCF can calculate the appropriate compensation quickly.

Registration Information

In order to allow potential claimants to meet the deadlines established in the Zadroga Act *even if they are uncertain whether they will eventually file a claim*, the VCF allows individuals an opportunity to "register" with the Fund, thereby preserving the right to file a claim in the future. Registration does not create an obligation or commitment to file a claim and the Special Master expects that a large percentage of registrations will not result in claims being filed as they are either duplicates or were created by individuals who will eventually decide not to file a claim. The table below shows the registration data. The number of Interim Registrations is applicable only to the October 3, 2013, filing deadline and therefore has not changed since the last report.
